Project Name: Elderwood Sewer Project

Project Location: The project is located on Elderwood in City of Lake Forest (Exhibit A)

County: Orange

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) owns, operates and maintains a sewer pipeline, located on Elderwood in the City of Lake Forest. This pipeline transports sewage from nearby residences to IRWD's sewage plants for treatment. Recent inspections indicated that a portion of the pipeline required replacement and a second portion of the pipelines required relining.

This project involves the replacement of a portion of an existing sewer pipeline. Approximately 260 linear feet of sewer pipe will be replaced in Elderwood, between Arborwood and Poplarwood. In addition to the replacement pipe, a separate 260 linear foot segment of sewer pipe will be re-lined in Elderwood, between Poplarwood and Sprucewood. The scope of work will include bypass pumping as necessary to perform the work and also includes replacement of frames, covers, and grade rings for three sewer manholes.

Reasons why project is exempt:

The Elderwood Sewer Pipeline project includes the replacement of approximately 260 linear feet of sewer pipeline with a new poly-vinyl chlorite (PVC) pipe and the installation of approximately 260 feet of cured in place sewer pipeline on Elderwood in the City of Lake Forest. State Guideline §15302 provides exemption for the replacement of existing facilities where the new facility will be located on the same site as the facility replaced and will have substantially the same purpose as the facility replaced. Additionally, State Guideline §15282 provides exemption for the installation of new pipeline as long as the project does not exceed one mile in length (i.e. 5,210 ft).

Submission of this form is optional. Local agencies may file this form with the county clerk pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21152(b). The filing of the notice starts a 35-day statute of limitations on court challenges to the approval of the project under Public Resources Code Section 21167(d). Failure to file the notice results in the statute of limitations being extended to 180 days.
