Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) owns, operates and maintains 36 drinking water reservoirs throughout its service area in Orange County, California. A recent Division of Drinking Water (DDW) inspection of IRWD's water system facilities found that the air vents at certain reservoirs do not meet DDW requirements.
