Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) owns and operates the existing Lake Forest Well 2, located in Lake Forest on Osterman Road. Lake Forest Well 2 was reconstructed in 2011 and is permitted for use as a potable water supply. The well was shut down in 2019 due to increased color resulting from iron and manganese.

The Project will install a new treatment system at the existing wellhead for removal of the iron and manganese. Additionally, the Project will include rehabilitation of the existing well, pilot testing, construction of a waste discharge pipeline for off-specification and backwash waters, and all ancillary piping, electrical, and instrumentation.
