



Meter Application Requirements

All items listed below must be presented along with the application when applying for water meter(s). Our office cannot accept information submitted separately or by email. If information is missing, application will not be accepted.

Please allow 2-3 weeks from the time information is received, complete and correct, to process. An email will be sent to you with a copy of the completed application and number to call for activation.

Custom homes and homes dual-plumbed with recycled water for irrigation have separate applications and require approved landscape plans.

To activate a meter, please leave a voicemail on the meter activation line at 949-453-5426 and your previously submitted and processed applications will be routed.

1 Approved Civil Plans

11" x 17", one per meter (i.e. 10 meters, 10 plans). Provide only the sheet that the meter appears on. Highlight meter location and write in address. Please also provide one index map per meter with its civil station location called out.

2 Approved Landscape Plans for Recycled Water

11" x 17", one per meter. Highlight meter location and write in address. Please also provide one index map per meter with its civil station called out.

3 City Approved Address Document for Unique Address

All meters must have a unique address even if all meters are serving the same location. Addresses with fractions will not be accepted; acceptable variations of the address may include decimals up to two places (e.g. 123.25 Main St.)

4 Connection/Meter Fees

Meter(s) for domestic service to residential buildings may be pre-paid with bonds and agreements. Connection fees are due prior to obtaining a meter(s). If meter and connection fees are not pre-paid, a check will need to be provided for the fee amounts with the application. **One check per IRWD code.**

5 OCFA Approval Documents

5/8 x 3/4" Disc and 3/4" Disc meters may require approval documents from OCFA or governing fire agency.
