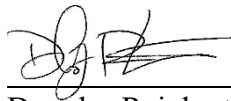

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF IRVINE RANCH WATER DISTRICT WATER SERVICE CORPORATION
APPOINTING ADDITIONAL OFFICERS

A. Irvine Ranch Water District Water Service Corporation, a California non-profit public benefit corporation (the "**Corporation**") was duly established on January 23, 1997.

B. Section 21 of the Corporation's Bylaws provides that the offices of Secretary and Treasurer of the Corporation shall be filled, ex officio, by the Secretary and Treasurer, respectively, of Irvine Ranch Water District (the "**District**").

C. Section 21 of the Corporation's Bylaws also provides that the Corporation may have, at the discretion of the Board of Directors, one or more Assistant Secretaries and one or more Assistant Treasurers.

D. Section 23 of the Corporation's Bylaws provides for the Board of Directors to authorize the appointment of other officers of the Corporation, to hold office for such period of time as authorized by the Board of Directors.

E. The Corporation intends by this Resolution to authorize the appointment one or more Assistant Secretaries and one or more Assistant Treasurers in an ex officio capacity.

The Board of Directors of Irvine Ranch Water District Water Service Corporation therefore resolves as follows:

1. Any Assistant Secretary and any Assistant Treasurer of the District is hereby appointed as an Assistant Secretary or Assistant Treasurer, respectively, of the Corporation and shall retain that position concurrently with their role with the District. If any individual serving in one of the appointed positions ceases to hold that position for any reason, their successor in that position at the District will automatically succeed to become an officer with the Corporation without any further action needed by the Corporation's Board of Directors.

2. This resolution will take effect immediately upon its adoption.

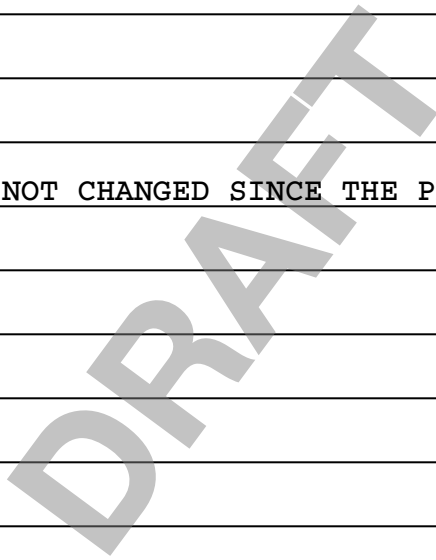

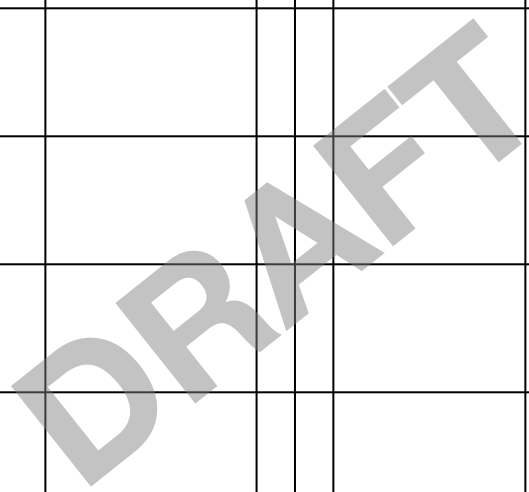
