Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Existing Well 110 is located in the City of Irvine is need of rehabilitation. This well is a major contributor to the Irvine Desalter Project Potable Treatment Plant. A video survey conducted last year showed some biological growth throughout the well. While the well has not yet experienced significant declines in production capacity, a well rehabilitation program was prepared to address the biological growth issue and ensure that the production capacity is maintained at a high level. Testing of the well will include collecting data to ensure the well is properly rehabilitated.

Work to be performed on this existing well includes scrubbing the well walls, repair of any well wall defects, and well testing consisting of data collection to determine the need for chemical treatment and determine the quality of well water discharge. There will be no expansion of use of this site as a result of this project. This work is exempt under Categorical Exemption 15301 and 15306.
